

### **Greenwich Public Schools Profile**

Greenwich Public Schools (GPS) consist of eleven neighborhood elementary schools, three middle schools (6-8), and one high school (9-12). Students are assigned to elementary and middle schools based on residential attendance areas. Four of the elementary schools and one middle school serve as partial magnet schools, offering programmatic choice for families.

The 2015-2020 GPS Strategic Plan is designed to drive academic, personal and interpersonal growth by providing personalized learning opportunities for each student, using traditional and digital tools and resources. The GPS provide a standards-based curriculum, instruction grounded in research and best practice, a comprehensive assessment system, and a personalized professional development program that serves as a model in Connecticut.
