Wyandanch takes its name from the Montaukett leader, Chief Wyandanch, who acted as a liaison between the English the other natives negotiating peace treaties. Wyandanch is a suburb with a population of 13,601 located in Suffolk County. Living in Wyandanch offers residents a sparse suburban feel with most residents owning their homes. Wyandanch has a station along the Main Line (Ronkonkoma Branch) of the Long Island Railroad which provides easy access to our surrounding neighborhoods and cities.
