Deadline and Selection

All materials submitted as part of the principal application will remain confidential to the extent allowed by law, which includes review in a closed session. After all applications have been reviewed and preliminary interviews conducted by the consulting firm, the names of the semifinalists will be presented to the Moffat County Superintendent for consideration. Selection of candidates for final interviews is the sole responsibility of the district. Persons wishing to be considered for the position should submit an application file online including:

- A letter of application stating personal qualifications, experiences, and reasons for interest in the position.

- 4 current letters of recommendation.
